The levels you are required to reach for each competency vary across sector pathways and depending on whether you are applying to be an Associate Member (AssocRICS) or a Chartered Member (MRICS).

Level	Entry–mid (0 to 4 years+)	Chartered (APC, Senior, Specialist or Academic).
Interview	 No	 Yes
Competency	Knowledge understanding and practice	Up to Level 3
Judgement required	Basic	Advanced
Case study	Simpler	Strategic + client advice

MRICS levels:

Level 1 – knowledge and understanding

Level 2 – application of knowledge

Level 3 – depth and synthesis of technical knowledge and implementation.
