The profile of our community can help with the UK national skills shortages and partners with housing supply.

The AMS Community.

People within the community say we cannot see anyone who looks like us in the industry, in our community people do not understand our work.

Access and entry due to lack of guidance and support are hard and career longevity is an issue, being a lone person means people can be an easy target.

People come from a disadvantage, First in the family at university, it was well-known that people from Bangladeshi, Pakistani, and Muslim Communities were some of the worst hit during the COVID-19 pandemic.

They are relatively poor and occupy insecure jobs, the Office of National Statistics (UK) data shows they suffer great economic disadvantage, 41% of the economically inactive are Muslim women.

Most of the community is young, the youngest 16-25 with the majority 25-34, the second highest majority is between 35-44, with only a handful of people between 55-64 and no one that is over 65, people are from all over the world.

The Community says advocacy and representation are key and visibility, the drinking culture in the industry precludes them, We are the fastest growing community in UK society, it is a missed opportunity not to connect with us.

#### Activities

Advocacy and representation, the Professional Real Estate Institutions such as RICS, RIBA, RTPI, CIOB, ICE support initiatives such as AMSI, the RICS were part of our start, and we work with them often.

The first Event on 3 May 2023, was a good opportunity in terms of creating a market presence, AMSI is known in the UK and has built global connections, single-handed we raised the profile of an institution in a whole new community.

Our  $2^{nd}$  event on 12 July 2023 at RICS HQ focused on learning and development, and how to become chartered, This is important, for example, a chartered surveyor can earn 1/3 more than someone who is not and more transferrable.



Private events. 12 September we had a private event with the RICS President at the London Central Mosque.

We work on an event at Cambridge Mosque. We have the offer of a Birmingham venue for an event. Others invite us to their event such as an Islamophobia Awareness Month event. We would like to do a first-anniversary event.

We expect to repeat what we did next year and build on this. Where contributing members and volunteers want to lead on initiatives, we will start to look at funding opportunities. For a sustainable service, financial viability is key.
